While you will lead and support a small regional team, this role is not primarily focused on internal management. It is for a visionary, faith-driven leader who thrives on opening new doors, inspiring generosity, communicating vision with authenticity and inviting others to join God's work of transforming children's lives.

You will represent Stand by Me at churches, events and conferences, and lead overseas project visits, helping supporters experience first-hand the life-changing impact of their giving.
